Call to Order by Shirrod, 5:12pm

AC unit for transmitter Alaska Building, \$ 5348 new unit that will fit in current space.

Hire electrician—\$300-400

Pay shipping-several hundred

Used AC unit would be about half the price, but would need new unit built

One year warranty

Ask about discount for nonprofit

Meghan says buy new, Nichole agrees

Motion for Approval to purchase new AC unit for the transmitter on the Alaska building (Rayhill), Second (Lopez) Passed 6-0

Owyhee Ridge Power Amplifier

New one \$15,000

Rebuilt same model \$4801.61

Send the malfunctioning one to get it repaired for \$1500-\$2000 won't be returned for 90 days

Could need to file with FCC d/t lack of broadcast. No repercussions

Send the unit for rebuild:

Motion to Approve repair of current power amplifier (Lopez), Second (Stuesse)
Passed 5-0
