**NFCB Conference Report** (National Federation of Community Broadcasters) Wayne Birt:

Building Dynamic Programming: 90% of listeners are not donors, feels Radio Boise numbers are better than that

Phone donations plummeting, keep line open for feedback during fund drives

Streaming Analytics: handle on data, how to interpret and strategies
Fighting Fear: discussion of FCC regulations and what has never been
enforced such as admission prices and own events. Cannot direct public
